



Chinese porcelain blue white "water pot" decorated with lotus flowers. The handle in the shape of two "shi" dragons and the flaming pearl. Based on traditional glazed stoneware ewers for serving rice wine or tea in rural societies, more luxurious varieties were exported to Asian markets where they will have had a similar function - Kangxi period 1662/1722
